Why would anyone assume something or anything about someone?

The word itself sends a message when separated into three parts. You make a fool out of yourself and the assumption of the person in mind, especially if you spread rumours based on your thoughts of that person.

Personal conflict with another individual begins with what we view of that person. This attack is a result of suggestive thoughts that derive from the mind. Our assessment of the situation will be inaccurate, which creates more drama and tension for both you and the receiver.

Sometimes the receiver will detect this unusual behaviour based on the demeanour of the sender, especially if well-known to them. This influential behaviour comes from the evil one himself. For believers of God, we must deter from this concept because it could lead to sinful activity. The best solution is to ask questions to whomever your thoughts may dwell upon to possibly receive an accurate answer.
