Desires. What could happen to a person that decides not to follow Psalms chapter thirty-seven verse four? Well, Jacob, in the book of Genesis and Samson in the book of Judges. These examples of following the desires that did not have the outcome they expected.

The desire for something is a thought in mind based on what we think or by what we may see or have seen. This thought now lingers long enough becomes the pursuit of the person to inquire about making it a reality. The desire is now a goal. This person may use research or network to find the source to form a plan. At this stage, the pursuant is learning about the desire they have in mind. The obstacle is how much time will it take before fulfilment? How would it affect family, friends, loved ones, and other priorities?
