Why would anybody attempt to do something wrong to another person? There is always a reason for the sender. This attitude begins from the heart, coupled with the thoughts of the person. Either the sender is unable to cope with what the person has or what the person is doing. This behavior first manifests in Genesis with Cain slewing his brother Abel. God had to deal with a former fallen angel in the book of Isaiah, verses twelve to fourteen of chapter twelve. Mock is a plan the person imposes to imitate someone to get rid of or to get revenge. A mocker is someone that plans to create havoc until the receiver surrenders and does whatever the sender wants to alleviate that behavior. Mocking is a person that desires the other to suffer without remorse. God is against this behavior. That is why some mockers experience severe consequences for their actions. Mock is better known as a copycat. To pretend to be like somebody that you are not. For example, God's number is seven, and the devil is 6. God loves people, and the devil hates people. God sends His son to save people, and the devil sends his demons to destroy them.

A person that mocks, or a mocker, or mocking, is unable to deal with the one intended. The only way for the sender to not behave this way is to stay away from that person or not see them.
