What is an usher? A church usher is a person who helps ensure a church service operates in an orderly manner and who ministers to people in a variety of practical ways. The usher responsibilities start with the church offering, greeting members and visitors, and directing people to their seats. Other usher duties are personal requests from the people that need attention. The role of the usher in the church is critical during the service and even after the service. The safety of all participants while in the church is vital for an usher. These people include the pastor, leaders, staff in the church, members, and visitors. The usher must be able to be alert during the service visually while being a part of the service spiritually. Ushers, more importantly, must have a close relationship with God to execute his role within the church. Often at times, usher attention is diverted towards the wellbeing of the people in the service. Therefore, they might not receive the message or see the events as a patron sitting in the service.
