No Growth is the spirit within and the physical structure of a human being that decides not to serve God. This decision naturally amplifies the flesh to exercise its tendencies while the inner person is prohibited.

Everyone inside their heart has intentions of good towards all humanity. However, if our choice is not to follow God and His ways, it will be difficult to reach. Since the flesh has permission and leads the way, this preference opens the door for sin and evil to rule.

Rebellion is the opposite of obedience. Good is contrary to bad. The Inner person is closer to the heart than the outer, but to get the right intentions out to exercise is blocked by the ruler: the flesh.

That explains when believers communicate with unbelievers and speak to them about God. The flesh behaves in sleep mode, not allowing the words to penetrate because if it does, then the inner being will be alive.

The unbelievers will defend when believers try to convince them to follow. The longer the conversation, the more intense. It depends upon how deep each other is within their own beliefs. Another way unbelievers deal with situations with believers is to give them no time. Respond with the "too busy" remark and depart.

Unbelievers will conceal themselves from people of God due to worldly pleasures. The things that contaminate their minds: include sin and evil, make it quite a challenge for the believer.

Rebellious people will make excuses towards believers that they are too tired. The flesh of an unbeliever knows the difference between godly or ungodly suggestions that would jeopardize their lifestyles.

To change an unbeliever to a believer is only by the confession that comes from the heart to allow the inner person to regain control from the flesh.
