There are three things that the devil entices people to develop in their lives before potentially tempting them to commit the other sins: to possess pride, to lie, and to lust. Lust, the last commandment in the Bible, which is to covet, is the worst of the three. Pride takes pleasure, lies tell untruths, but lust desires strongly.

Why is lust so dangerous? How does it come to form within a person?



Lust begins with the look. It is funny sometimes how you hear relationships come together. Some stories of a couple's encounter: they saw the look in their eyes, the way she walks, the way he flexes his muscles, the wink in her eye, the sound in his voice, etcetera. Some of these examples of encounters tend not to last. *Why? One within the relationship joined for different reasons: Lust.
