What is a conspiracy? Conspiracy is the activity of people privately preparing to do something unlawful to another person. Conspiracy is generated by one who convinces the others based on a combination of assuming and presuming notions. Why would anyone endeavor to attempt to hurt another? Conspiracy is associated with some form of envy or jealousy. The Son of God experienced this evil activity that led Him to become the Savior of the world.

The first stage of a conspiracy is the complaint. The person or people grumbles to another about the innocent human being of whom they plan to conspire. The complainer, having the passion for what the possessor owns, connives the others involved to cooperate. The Son of God dealt with this attitude when He was going about doing good. However, the same people He helped is where some of these same people turned against Him.

Inspection is the leading role of conspiracy. The person that desires the quality or property of another instantly. However, if the person inspecting the other does not receive that desired quality directly, the owner may encounter retaliation from that inspector. Conspiracy is motivated by information. Gossip by a group of people or rumor by one person often generates a reaction to the one intended. The difference between conspiracy and gossip is the silence factor. Navigating around the person that the evil motive is against cunningly can be confusing. Conspirators can be judgmental. The Son of God stood before the people along with a criminal before a judge to determine their punishment. The crowd emotionally persuaded their judge to free the criminal and punish the Son of God. The criminal notoriously did wrong while the Son of God did right. This decision was motivated by envy. Conspirators tend to endeavor to provoke the person they are targeting. They may resort to distraction to get their attention, nitpick directly to them about something unimportant, mimic before them intentionally, or influence others to ignore the person completely. Conspiracy is to defame another person. The conspirators plan to ruin the personality of the one by changing the hearts of others negatively towards that person. The satisfaction of conducting such corruptible activity to that individual in itself is heartless. Conspirators involved in the unlawful activity seek privately to blame the person. Why? The people in conspiracy activity do it because the quality or possession that person owns is hindering them. The only way for the schemers to disrupt this desired thing is to minimize the attention with false accusations. Conspiracy may endanger the person involved with strife. The schemers involved will attempt to create some problems to get the individual to react in a hostile manner to warrant evil retaliation. Conspirators are envious and tend to be unhappy rather than happy with that person due to the quality or possession. Conspiracy is evil work against another that people adopt to alleviate the inability to develop or possess that someone owns. To conspire is to walk in fire.
